Tuesday, November 14th

The FRQ will have two stimuli (graph, map etc.) with seven prompts divided between the two.

Students should be able to:

- **Analyze/explain** a visual representation related to the demographic transition model, population pyramids and/or dependency ratios and explain the role of gender and development and factors in shaping the demographics of a country.
- **Understand** Malthusian Theory and government responses to population issues.
- **Analyze/explain** a visual representation depicting **international immigration flows into the U.S.** over time including source areas/ethnicities and related push/pull factors. You will need to be able to differentiate between sources areas, categories of push/pull factors and how they correspond to different immigration flows (see the key for the group assignment or my summary powerpoint).
