

**Free Response Question Exam (FRQ): Wednesday April 24<sup>th</sup>.** In-class writing assignment (28 minutes for non-extended time students, 42 minutes for extended time students. Both of these groups will be able to complete the FRQ exam within the assigned class period)

**Unit 7 topics:**

- **Christaller's Central Place Theory**
  - understand the settlement hierarchy and how it affects the distribution of services.
  - Be able to differentiate between different levels of services by applying Central Place Theory concepts and terms and give examples of services that would fit these characteristics.
  - Be able to apply this decision-making process of where a consumer would access a certain level of service based on their location.
- **Burgess' Concentric Zone Model and Density Gradient**
  - understand the built landscape and population density gradient for the Concentric Zone Model
  - be able to EXPLAIN/DESCRIBE the built landscape and population density pattern based on the traditional or mid-20<sup>th</sup> century situation (pre-auto)
  - be able to EXPLAIN/DESCRIBE changes to the population density and built landscape that the zones have experienced in the last 50 years (post-auto)

**Multiple Choice Exam: Thursday April 25<sup>th</sup>.** Exam will be 50 questions that cover both Units 5 and 7 (entered as a combined grade).
